Christopher Ducharme, a 2003 alumnus, experienced a childhood tragedy when he was only 14 years old when his mother was murdered.

Now, a full-time Scotiabank employee at the BC/Yukon Regional Office and an active voluntary Board Member of the **British Columbia Bereavement Helpline** (BCBH), Christopher is spearheading the **BC Victims of Homicide** initiative. His project responds to growing homicide numbers by providing victims with counselling and support services in a respectful and confidential environment.
