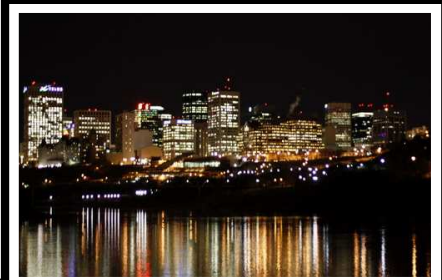

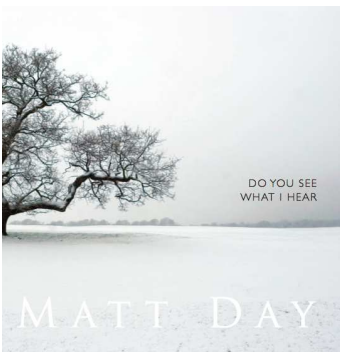
Calling all Artists
