While your degree planning is directed by the specific requirements for your chosen concentration and minor, it is also driven by your own personal interests; therefore, it is most effective when you are the master of your own academic planning.

Program planning can be very effective to identify potential courses needed in addition to specific requirements. Refer to section 4.0 in the *Concordia Calendar* for more information regarding registration policies. You are responsible for registering in and completing the courses necessary to obtain your degree. The *Concordia Calendar* is the final authority regarding program requirements and academic regulations.

Core course requirements may be fulfilled through both concentration or minor requirements; however, the same course may not be counted toward both concentration and minor requirements. (Example: courses taken toward a History minor simultaneously fulfill the Social Science core).

#### **Concentration Requirements**

#### 24-30 credits required to include:

- a) DRA 101 or 102
- b) One of DRA 149, 325 or 353
- c) One of DRA 247 or 352
- d) One of DRA 425, 450, 453, or 483
- e) 12-18 credits of unspecified Drama courses

Note: A maximum of 9 credits of junior-level Drama courses may be counted towards a Drama concentration.
